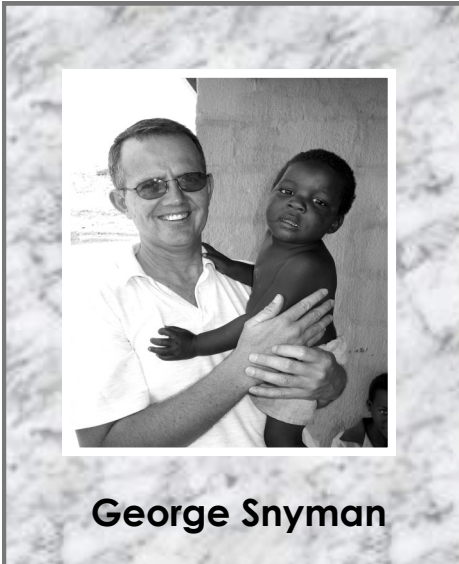


Plenary Speakers' Biographies

"You can only offer up your promised Isaac if you understand your destiny to another City."

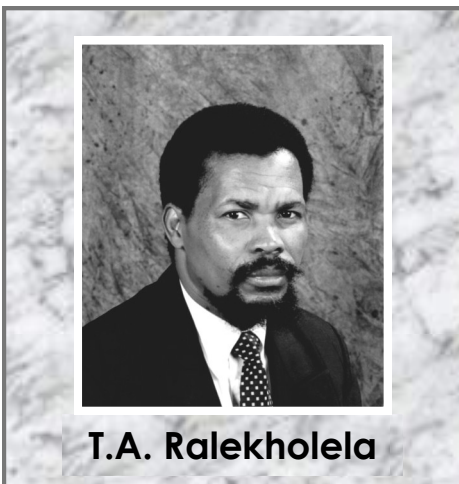
